

Tranby College has been spending these recent months readying for the introduction of the Tranby College Personal Education Plan. As a school we want to be able to celebrate each student's success and with this in mind we are engaging families and students in the creation of individual student goals to begin in 2021. Staff from the College will be working with each and every student in creating, monitoring, supporting and then celebrating goals that students have set for themselves in consultation with families and teachers. This is an exciting new development for Tranby College and one of the great benefits and assets of being a small school where each student's individual needs and interests are being catered for.

In addition to the above we are introducing dedicated Literacy Blocks in the Junior School. Literacy is a key for academic success and so we are introducing dedicated, uninterrupted time for students to focus on their literacy. This will be supported by a significant professional development program that our Junior School staff have been working on this year. We have been trialling this program in classes and this will be introduced from the start of next year for all Junior School classes. All our Junior School students will benefit from this new initiative.

In addition, we are also introducing a Gifted and Talented program for students in Years 5, 6, 7 and 8. Students will be invited to participate in this program based on data from academic testing and will provide an extension program for our most able students. We want all students to advance and from next year we will have mechanisms for students who need academic support because of particular needs, as well as extension for our most able students.
