

ABOUT TRANBY

Tranby College is a co-educational school of the Uniting Church in Australia, enrolling student from Kindergarten to Year 12, and is located in Settler Hill, Baldivis. Tranby College is renowned for being a friendly and welcoming school, with an attractive green aesthetic and excellent facilities.

The College was founded in 1997 and was named after the brig Tranby which arrived in the Swan River Colony in February 1830, bringing a group of Methodist settlers to the fledgling community.

The community of Tranby College includes a Junior School (Kindergarten – Year 6) and Senior School (Years 7–12). The Tranby Childcare Centre is also located on campus.

As well as providing a wide range of opportunities for its student and boasting strong programs in Academics, the Arts, Technologies and Sport. We also offer an extensive STEM (Science, Technologies, Engineering, Mathematics) Program for students in Years 5 and 6.

The College's enrolment policy is based on inclusivity. Places are offered according to the date on which an initial application is completed, although preference is given to siblings of students who are already enrolled and to children of staff.
